


JANUSZ GILEWICZ

Janusz Gilewicz is known as the world's "most famous unknown artist" (Mati Klarwein). Janusz is both a Renaissance style painter and a trend breaking innovator. In over five decades of creation and discovery, Janusz has pushed the boundaries of his classical education and developed his own techniques for painting on canvas, board, and paper as well as alternative surfaces such as goose feathers, leather apparel, concrete, the "living hologram," and walkable floors. Janusz has painted for the Saint John Paul II, famous musicians, and respected collectors. He has also created the world's largest 3-D mural in the Lower East Side of Manhattan. Janusz lives and works in New York City and travels the world. He has executed a number of art projects internationally. In his own words, "taste matters."






By moving the light source around the work, the image appears and disappears. In conjunction with the painting and the light source, the surface reveals and hides Sophia's face. When this happens, an extraordinary phenomenon in art manifests: form becomes the void and the void becomes a form, intertwined within real time. On the right page, Sophia is lit from two different light sources at 45 degree angles, creating additional 3-D effects.


























